

TOWN OF WESTBORO – ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 103 REGARDING DRIVEWAY/ CULVERT POLICY – NEW OR REPLACEMENT

The Town Board of Westboro, Taylor County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

- (1) No person shall make any excavation or fill or install any culvert or make any other alteration in any town highway maintained by the Town of Westboro or in any manner disturb any such town highway or bridge without first receiving a permit from the Town of Westboro.

Such permit shall contain the specifications necessary for the work to be properly constructed subject to such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the Town of Westboro, and must be performed and completed to its satisfaction.

The minimum size for a culvert is reduced from 15” to 12”.

Due to lot size within the Westboro Sanitary District boundaries, the driveway width would be reduced from 25’ down to 18’ to utilize a standard 20’ culvert.

The Town of Westboro will inspect the site and if completed satisfactorily, permit approval will be granted. In the case of temporary alterations, the highway or bridge shall be restored to its former condition and the permittee shall be liable to the Town of Westboro for all damages which occur during the progress of said work or as a result thereof.

If any culvert is installed or any excavation or fill or any other alteration is made in violation of the provisions of this subsection, the highway may be restored to its former condition by the highway authority in charge of the maintenance thereof; and any person who violates this subsection shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00, together with any costs incurred by the Town in restoring the highway to its former condition.

- (2) The term “highway” used herein shall have the same definition as used in Wisconsin Statutes, which relate to Town Highways.

- (3) This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
