

AMENDED - ORDINANCE NO. 111

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS DURING WINTER MONTHS AND DESIGNATING A PERSON TO DECLARE A SNOW EMERGENCY.

The Town Board of Westboro, Taylor County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be no parking of any vehicle, on any public street within the Westboro Sanitary District boundaries, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on any day between November 1st of each year and April 1st of the following year.

SECTION 2. Any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance may, at the discretion of the Road & Maintenance Director, be towed away and stored at the owner's expense, if such vehicle in anyway inhibits snow removal in any manner.

SECTION 3: Authority is hereby granted to the Road & Maintenance Director to declare a snow emergency. Such an emergency shall continue in effect for a period of 24 hours or until such time as the snow has been removed from the town's streets/roads or until the snow emergency has been rescinded by action of the Road & Maintenance Director.

Notice of the declaration of a snow emergency shall be given by notifying the local news media; however, such notification shall be a service aid only and not a duty on the part of said officials.

During a declared snow emergency no motor vehicle shall be left parked on any street or roadway in the town.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
